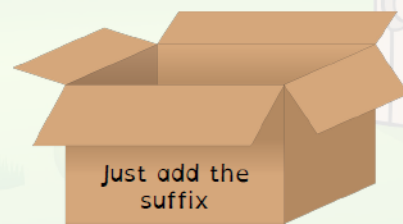
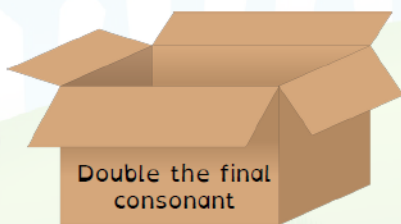
L.O: To add a suffix that starts with a vowel to words of more than one syllable where there final syllable is stressed.
