when the final letter is 'l.'

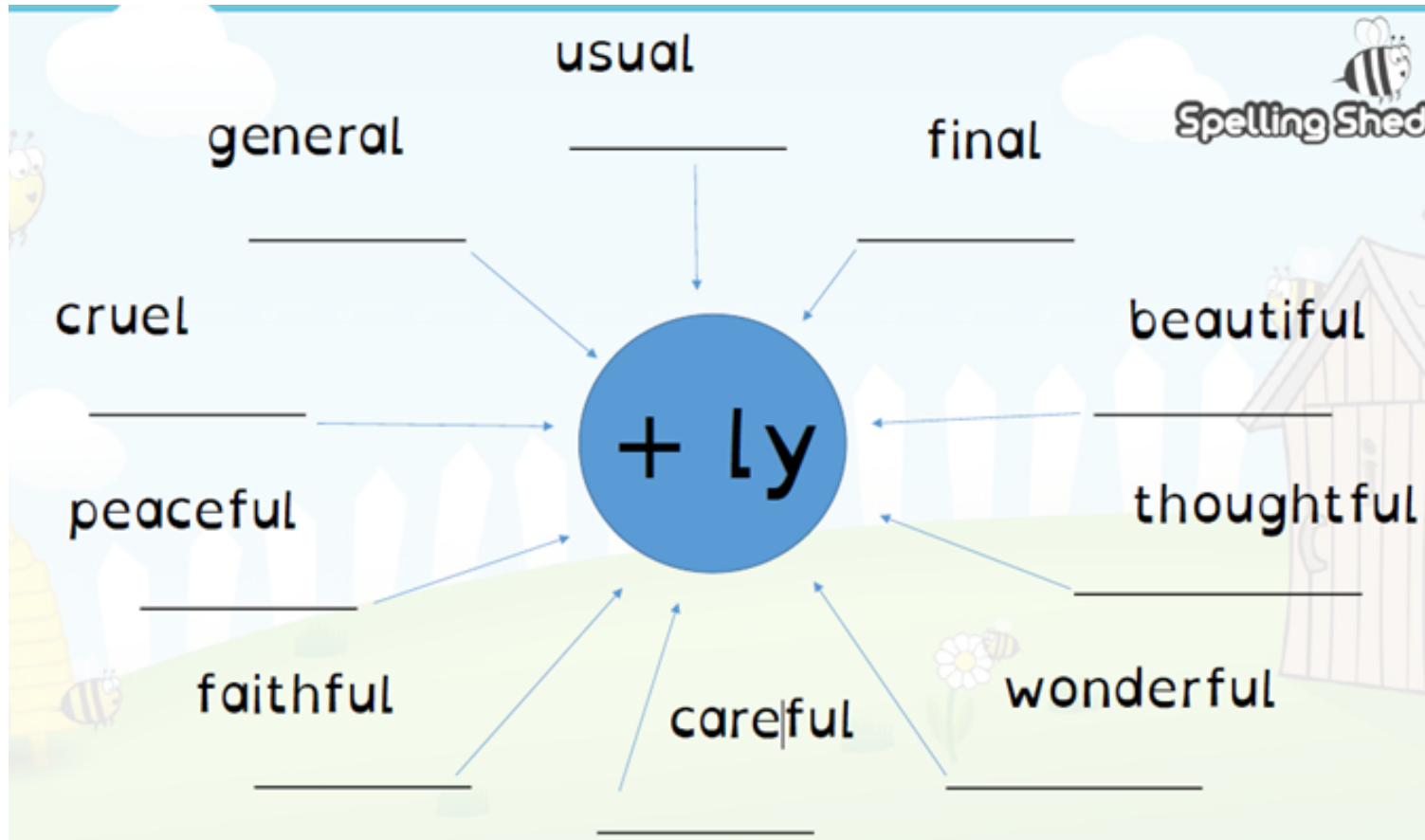
Adding 'ly' to an adjective that ends in 'l' will turn it in to an 'adverb' - 'how' something is done.

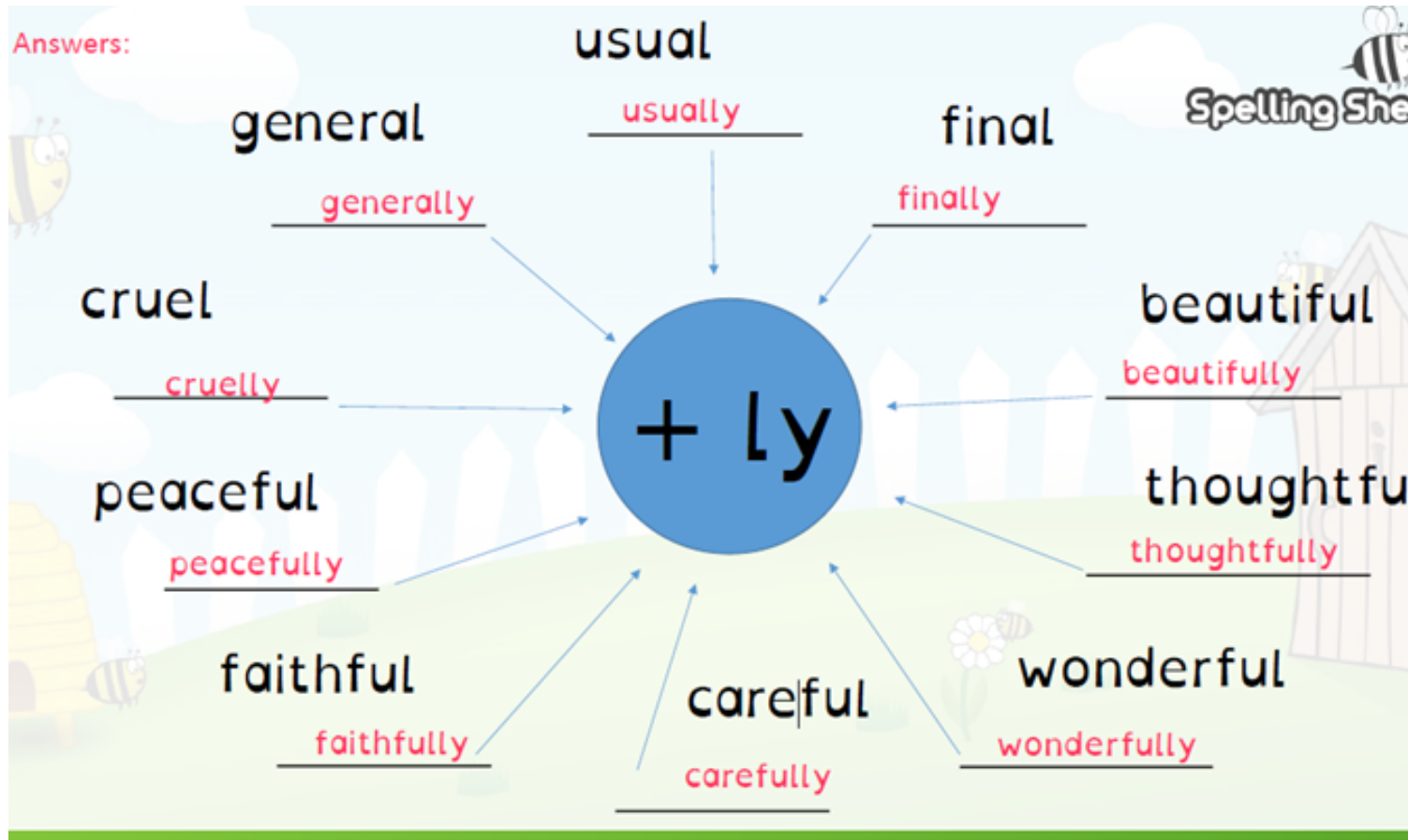
The rule is simple - if the root word ends in 'l' you add 'ly' straight on the end e.g.

beautiful becomes beautifully

Complete the power-point slide as quickly as possible, adding 'ly' to each of the root words to create their spelling words.

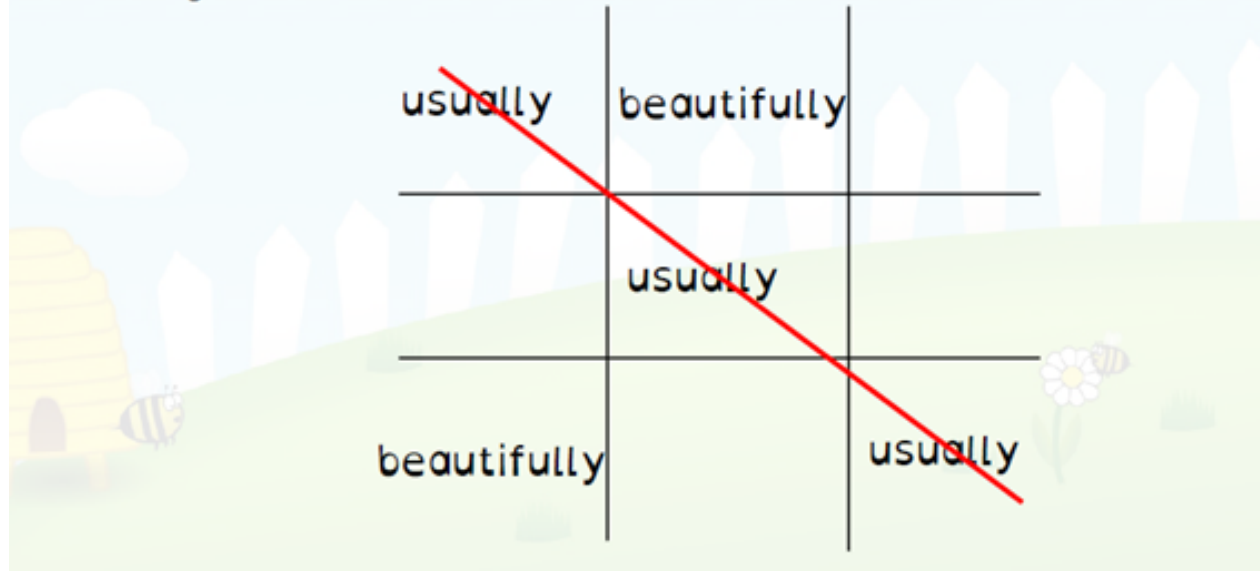




Task
