
Adding '-ly' to to turn an adjective into an adverbuble when the final letter is 'L'

Adding 'ly' to an adjective that ends in 'l' will turn it in to an 'adverb' - 'how' something is done.


The rule is simple - if the root word ends in 'l' you add 'ly' straight on the end e.g. beautiful becomes beautifully


