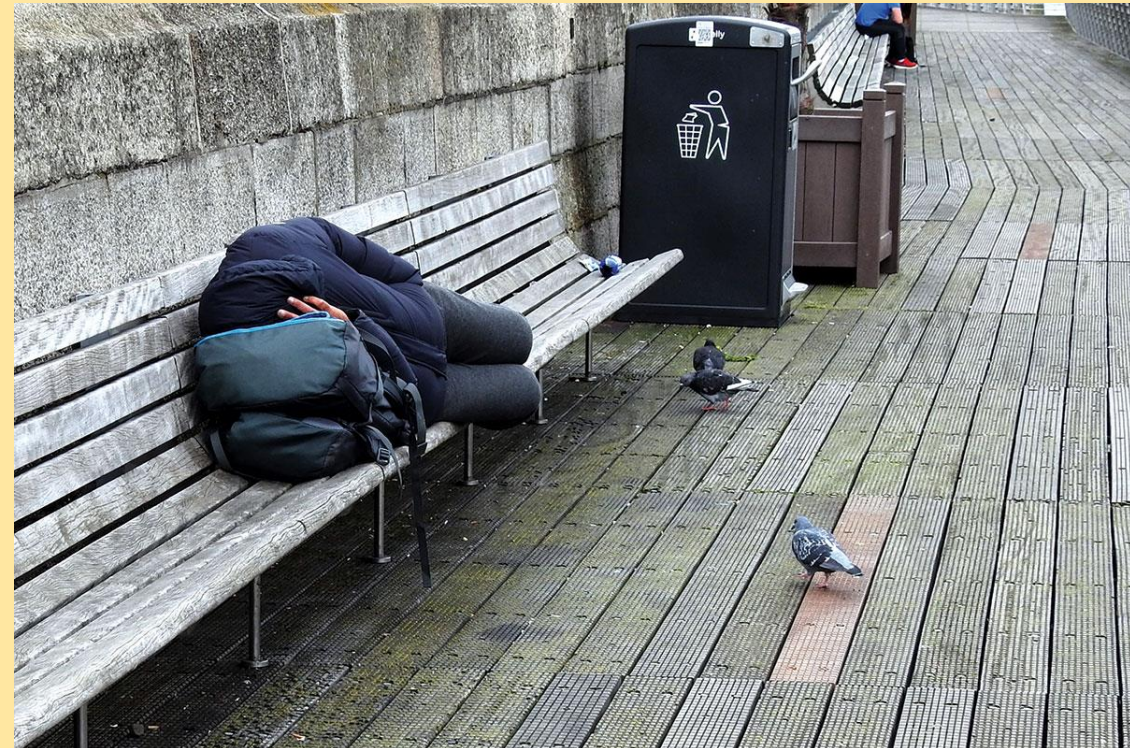


Paths Lesson 14 - Solving an Important Problem
