This will take place on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October. Jodrell Bank is an inspirational place full of mind-blowing stories of pioneering heritage and cutting-edge science. As part of our trip, pupils will take a guided tour of the Solar System and discover constellations in Jodrell Bank's Space



Dome. They will then continue their journey of discovery in their exhibitions, learning how the Lovell Telescope views the Universe and about the live science taking place at the UNESCO World Heritage Site
