A parent's guide to



Seesaw is digital platform that lets teachers keep in touch with children remotely.

Teachers can set assignments for children to complete at home.

Pupils can share their learning from home with the class teachers and their teacher can respond to the work they complete. All of this can be accessed by your child by simply logging in to Seesaw. You have been sent your child's Seesaw home learning code via email/ text or by you can request a paper copy of the QR code.

Broad Oak staff will use Seesaw for home learning on a daily basis with subject tasks being posted daily.

Class teachers will also use Seesaw to set activities during individual isolation or whole class isolation/closure. Activities will be posted to Seesaw on a daily basis with pupils expected to respond to each activity by posting their complete work. This can be done by using the writing tools built into Seesaw, completing work on paper packs available then photographing and uploading or printing work and photographing it. Teachers can then review the work completed.

Celebration of learning will also take place through the announcements section of Seesaw and this be sent every Thursday.
